THINGS TO CONSIDER WHEN ORDERING

1. COLOR SELECTION

As we offer a wide range of products and binding edges in various colors, it can be practical to have a fabric sample, a piece of wallpaper, or something else at hand to see how the colors complement each other.

It is also important to consider from the start what should stand out the most. If you have a very elegant piece of furniture, perhaps the rug shouldn't compete for attention. Conversely, you can create very exciting combinations that make the rug stand out.

Also, consider at this stage whether aesthetics or practicality takes precedence. A lighter product is more sensitive and tends to get dirty faster than a darker or patterned one.

2. DIMENSIONS, DESIGN, AND THICKNESS

We apply free sizing, meaning you are free to choose any dimensions, but we are limited to a maximum width of 4 or 5 meters, depending on the width of the master roll. There are no extra costs for waste!

For production reasons, we reserve the right to exceed or fall short of the specified dimensions by 1-2 cm.

Most of our products have a width and a length direction. We interpret all orders as having the first measurement as the width and the second as the length of the carpet. We only accept written orders.

Also, keep in mind that a rug with binding edges increases the thickness by 8-10 mm. This can sometimes cause problems with doors that need to open if the space between the floor and the bottom of the door is too small.

3. RUGS UNDER A DINING TABLE

If the rug is to be placed under a dining table, the measurement should be a minimum of 60 cm, preferably 75 cm larger on each side of the table. This is because chairs, when pulled out, can easily catch the edge of the rug if it is too small. Sometimes it is necessary to accept smaller dimensions due to limitations in the room size.

4. RUGS UNDER A SOFA GROUP

Rugs for sofa groups can either cover the entire group or parts of it. It is a matter of taste and preference.

5. RUNNERS

When it comes to runners, it is similar to rugs for sofa groups; you can choose the size that feels best. However, leave a minimum of 10 cm towards the wall so that the subfloor is visible, and the runner does not risk lying against the wall.

Also, note that a runner without a non-slip backing needs to be secured in some way. This can be done with a strong double-sided tape, a double-sided mesh on the subfloor, or you can apply a water-soluble adhesive to a part of the back of the rug.

6. ROUND AND ELLIPTICAL CARPETS

These types of rugs comes with an additional cost due to increased waste and additional time for cutting and sewing. When binding the edges of these rugs, the visible part of the binding can be a maximum of 30 mm, as the rug may otherwise "cup."



7. CUSTOMIZED PRODUCTION

We can create a variety of "specials" and are happy to provide quotes for unusual carpets. In such cases, it is important that we receive an accurate sketch or drawing. It's good to know that, in addition to our regular hand collections, we have a variety of special bindings with different patterns.

8. FINISHING WITH INVISILOC OVERLOCK

Almost all of our products, if they need to be finished, regardless of material, can be finished with INVISILOC®, which is a proprietary method using a special thread that provides a discreet tone-on-tone effect.

9. EDGING WITH LINEN OR COTTON BINDINGS

Our single-colored linen and cotton bindings are of extra sturdy quality and have a width of 120 mm. The visible part of the binding is approximately 50 mm wide. If desired, we can make the visible part narrower, but not narrower than 30 mm. If the visible part of the binding is to exceed 50 mm, we must sew on an additional binding that is placed on the underside. The visible part then becomes a maximum of 90 mm.

It is also possible to have two single-colored bindings visible on the top. Usually, the innermost binding is 20-30 mm wide, and the outermost is approximately 50 mm wide.

10. EDGING WITH ELMO LEATHER

To edge with leather, we cut strips from hides and sew them together to form a binding. This results in a relatively large number of cross-stitches on a carpet with a leather edge. The leather edge is sewn together with a binding edge placed on the back. The visible part is approximately 55 mm wide. A wider visible part can be offered upon request.

11. EDGING WITH DURALUX SUEDE IMITATION

Our suede imitation binding is done with a specially durable and robust product that we are unique in offering. This variant, providing a more lively edge, is very realistic, and the visible part of the binding is approximately 55 mm wide. If desired, we can make the visible part narrower, but not narrower than 30 mm. If the visible part of the binding is to exceed 55 mm, we must sew on an additional binding placed on the underside. The visible part then becomes a maximum of 100 mm.

12. IMPREGNATION

Before delivery, our carpets can be impregnated with a special impregnating agent. This treatment makes it more difficult for dirt and liquids to penetrate the fibers, making stain removal easier. However, despite the treatment, we cannot guarantee that all stains will be removed. For information on stain removal, see the instructions under care instructions.

A fully laid carpet can be impregnated directly after installation. Contact us for more information.

Please note that our Venedig quality is factory-impregnated as standard.

13. INDENTATIONS

A wall-to-wall installed product can almost always show indentations from furniture over time, which can sometimes be troublesome when rearranging or moving furniture. Some indentations may disappear after a after some time, while others may never vanish. If this is a crucial point, choose a product of a harder and smoother type where furniture cannot leave such strong indentations.

Sometimes, a delivered product may have a broader indentation that spans the entire width of the roll. However, these typically disappear after a short time.

14. TIPS AND TRICKS

If the corners of the carpet start to stand up due to "involuntary kicks," bend the corners in the opposite direction to counteract this.

If the binding edge of the rug is not entirely smooth upon delivery, lightly spray it with water so that the binding tightens. Note that really chunky rugs may not always achieve a completely smooth binding edge.

Sometimes, it can be beneficial to use an iron on the binding edge or the top of the rug to eliminate tensions and wrinkles.
